

Guest Mike Barlow- Came to speak to Session regarding the Fire Alarm System at 6:45 pm. He told us that our SDG fire alarm system has a battery backup, and that if the power goes out, the alarm will still function. Once the power is restored, the batteries should recharge automatically. He suggested that maybe we should call a different company to monitor our fire alarm system. Mike also suggested that we call the Fire Department if we have an issue with the power going out or if we smell gas. They will come to check the buildings and see if we need to call the electric or gas company.

Welcome: Reverend Gaden, declaring a quorum, welcomed all to the December 16, 2024 Session Business Meeting and opened in prayer.

7:00 PM-Devotion, Pastor Gaden

The Devotions are based on *Isaiah 9:6-7* from *Wonder of Wonders: Christmas with Dietrich Bonhoeffer* by Dietrich Bonhoeffer, translated from the German by O.C. Dean Jr.

This reading is part of a Sermon to German Speaking church in Havana, Cuba, December 21, 1930.

"Wonderful Counselor" is the name of this child. God became human, the Word became flesh. God's love wins us and saves.

"Mighty God" is the name of this child. The child born to us is none other than God.

"Everlasting Father" is the name of this child. Whoever sees the Son, sees the Father.

"Prince of Peace" is the name of this child. Peace is made between God and humankind and among all people.

"Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace" is summed up for us in one name: Jesus.

Clerks Correspondence and Session Mail Box - Susan McCloughan

Review of Minutes: A motion was called to approve the minutes from November 18, 2024. All were in favor.

Mail Box/Clerk Correspondence- CCLI licensing sent a letter asking that we report our song usage starting from 10/1/24-3/31/25. Sue has started the process and will continue working on. I am working on updating the Church Directory. A new directory will be given out early next year. The 2025 dates were discussed regarding the Riverside Symphonia, the dates are: February 14 & 15, April 4 & 5. Sue will get back to Vickie from Riverside and give her the dates. Friendsgiving will be held at Titusville Pres., on January 12th. Sue Stokes from Mt. Airy is the POC. We'll have a sign up sheet here at our church on what to bring to the luncheon. Also, monetary donations will be accepted.

Discernment Process- The Session is continuing to review the "Turn the Page" documents that were handed out previously in regards to looking for a new Pastor. Pastor Jeanne Radak our Presbytery Leader, and Mt. Airy will be emailed to see if they are available for the discernment process on Monday 1/27/25, time to be determined, here at First Presbyterian Church of Lambertville. Sue will keep the Session informed.

Calendar Highlights from December 2024-March 2025

Communion is scheduled on 12/8 and 2/2, at Mt. Airy, and 1/5 and 3/2 here at First Pres. The information will be continuing in the bulletins for who is scheduled to give the upcoming Sermons and our Accompanists. The Christmas Eve Candlelight Service is 12/24 at 4:00 pm. The Ladies' Bible Study will be continuing on Wednesdays. The Session Prayer Meetings will take place on 12/2, 1/6, 2/3 and 3/3. Spanish Ministry will be continuing to meet at our church on Sundays at 3:00 pm. Riverside Symphonia are here for concerts on Feb. 15 & April 5. The Bell Choir will be playing in church in December. They will be resuming in Feb. 2025. The last day for Roller Skating is 3/21/25. The last day for the LBL is March 15th. The Annual Reports are due to the Church Office starting the week of January 6th. The Annual Congregational Meeting is on Sunday February 23rd after the worship service, with Installation Sunday on 3/5/25. The Soup Sales will be held on selected Saturdays in January, February and March during the basketball games. Ash Wednesday is on March 5th. The First Sunday in Lent is Mar. 9th. The Session Business Meeting was moved from 3/17 to 3/24.

Insurance Review- Is ongoing.

Young Adult Time- A message is given when the young adults are in church during the worship service.

Accompanist/Music Director- Lucia will not be taking the Music Director position. We will be continuing looking to fill the position. Lucia will be staying on as one of our Accompanists.

Spanish Ministry- Joanne spoke about the Spanish Ministry, and they are meeting here on Sundays at 3:00 pm. It's been a bit slow for them lately, and sometimes different people attend.

Joint Communion Services- This was discussed earlier in the Calendar section.

July Joint Service at Holcombe-Jimison- In March/April 2025 the committee will meet to discuss the upcoming service.

Building and Grounds – Pat Durborow/Phil McCloughan/Heather McIntyre/Don Pidcock

The **new technology** for the Livestream has been spotty. Stephen M. has been using his personal phone to record the services. Stephen had gotten in touch with Heather to see if they can come up with an alternative to our WIFI, maybe a satellite service. If that doesn't work, then they'll go back and look at other options. Heather and Phil discussed the possibility of calling in JCP&L to get a protection plan, we've been prone to power surges, and this can be damaging our equipment. Heather would call Holicong to see if we can get information regarding the alarm system. Pastor Linda suggested that we contacted the Presbytery to send someone to do a "Technological Analysis" to see what our technology problems are, and how they can be resolved. Heather will reach out to Debbie C., and work on this. I can reach out to Casey Carbone, who came to our church to help set up our Livestream.

Church Organ- The organ will look to be repaired after the church roof is completed.

Church Roof- Is being put on by Rainmaster. The metal roof is expected to be done soon, the gutters, and snow guards.

Skating- Patrick D. was running the skating last week, and Phil did the message. Skating will resume after the New Year.

Martinez Landscaping- They are continuing to service our yards. The amount of \$5331.00 was approved by the Session in October to repair the rock wall by the church and install a downspout in that area. This repair will be done soon.

Hallway in Church/Bathrooms/Front Door Issues- Hallway and front doors, will be taken care of in the spring. Joanne mentioned that the bathrooms need to be ventilated.

Church Heaters/Monthly Fire Inspections- Heather got in touch with Garden State Heating, and the 1st furnace was serviced. We are still waiting for a part on the 2nd heater. Don will get another pump for the dehumidifier. Don has been doing the monthly checks on the smoke detectors and Exit Signs.

Pastor Search Committee- The application from Princeton and the Music Director/ Accompanist job description was sent to Session for them to look over. Karen and Sue are waiting to hear back from Session for their approval to see if the information can be sent into the Princeton Seminary. The Discernment Process with Rev. Jeanne Radak will be coming up in January.

Report of Commissioner to the Presbytery- Phil is waiting for the next meeting. There is a course for Ruling Elders to be able to be put on the Pulpit Supply List. Pastor Linda will give Sue the information for this once it becomes available. There are several of our Session members that are interested in pursuing this option.

Budget and Finance – Heather McIntyre

The Year-to-Date Summary from 1/1-12/16/24, and that our plate giving is under \$1718.00. This was reviewed by Heather to Session.

Lowell Hunter Estate- No updates at this time.

Boy Scouts- No updates at this time.

The LPS using the gym- This is done, and the church did receive the last check from South Hunterdon.



2025 Per Capita- It's in the budget and the money for the Per Capita goes to our Missions.

2025 Budget- The last 2 pages of the financial reports given out tonight contain the 2025 Budget. They were reviewed by Heather to Session. A **motion** was made to approve the 2025 Budget. All were in favor.

Terms for the Session/Princeton Seminary- Heather and Joanne are going off Session in February 2025. Karen suggested that if necessary that both complete another year. Also, Karen asked that Session review the information that was sent regarding Princeton Seminary and to get the information back in.


