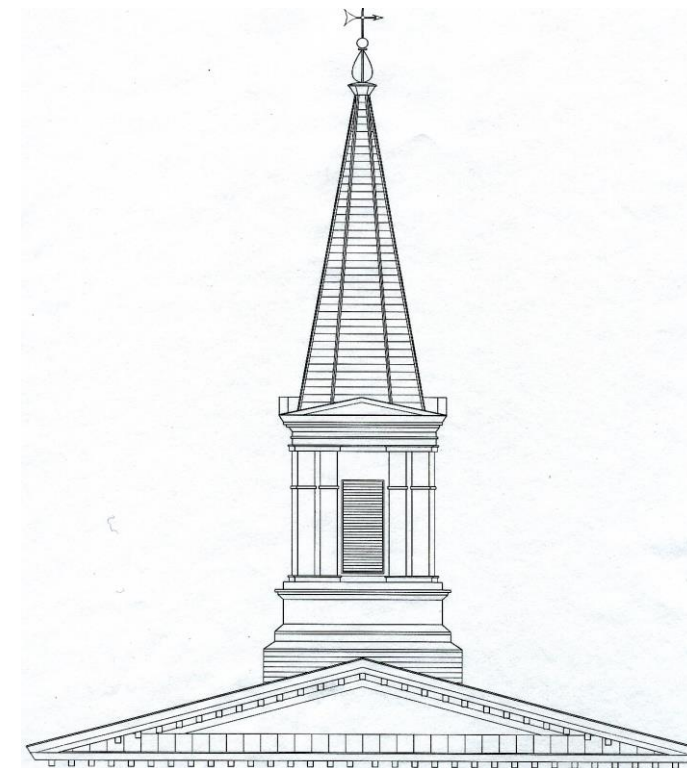

Hymn Time:

“Sweet Hour of Prayer”

William W. Walford (1772- 1850)

“Sweet Hour of Prayer” one of the world’s most poplar prayer hymns was written by a man who could not see. In 1842, the Reverend William W. Walford, a blind English Clergyman, dictated his inspirational poem of prayer to the Reverend Thomas Salmon, minister at the Congregational Church, Coleshill, England. Salmon took it with him on a journey to New York City, where it was published in September 1845.

Without doubt, Walford’s physical blindness gave him a spiritual sight to see, where many others could not see the tremendous significance of the power of illumination in prayer.

This hymn is an expression of the joy that can come when believers, individually and corporately, pray regularly.

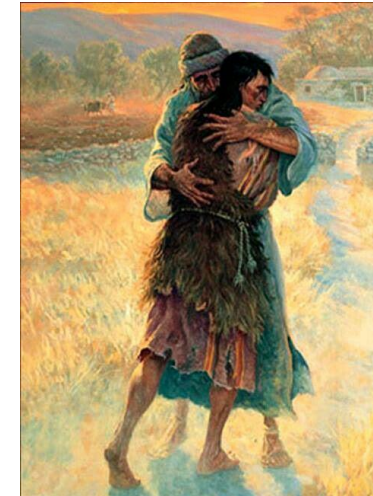
