"Fairest Lord Jesus"

Little is known of the origin of this inspiring hymn. It is thought by some to have been sung in the 12th century by German crusaders as they made their wearisome and dangerous trip to the Holy Land. Another source claims that this was one of the hymns used by the followers of John Hus. These were Moravian believers who were driven out of Bohemia in the bloody anti-Reformation purge of 1620. They settled in Silesia, now a part of Poland. Today's hymn is thought to be a folk song that came from these devout Silesian peasants.

This lovely hymn extolling the beauty and virtues of Christ leads us to the praise and worship of our "beautiful Savior". The vivid comparisons of all the enjoyable sights of nature with Jesus, who is the very source and essence of all beauty, fills us with awe. Then we are reminded that our Savior outshines all creations of God, including the hosts of angels. How worthy is He of the deepest "glory and honor, praise, adoration now and forevermore!"

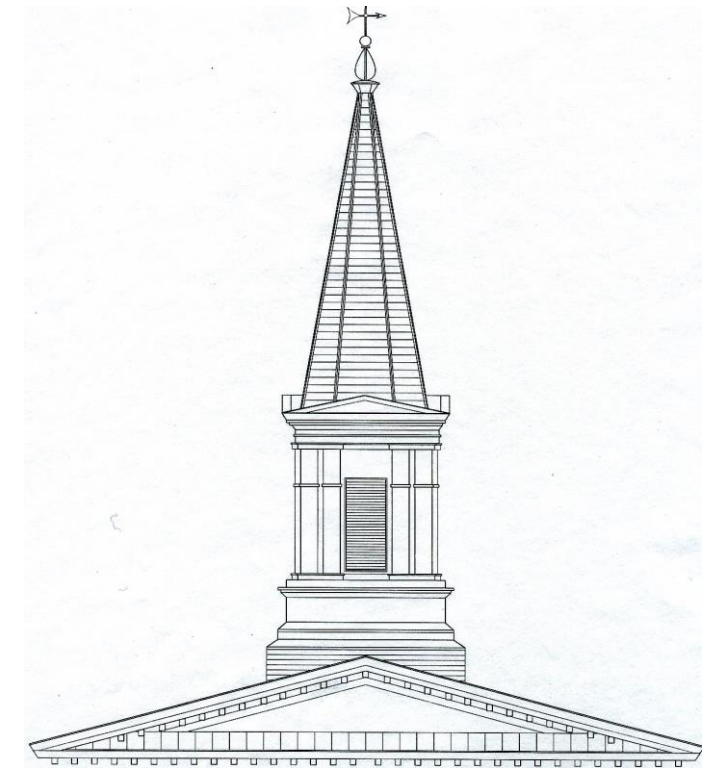
