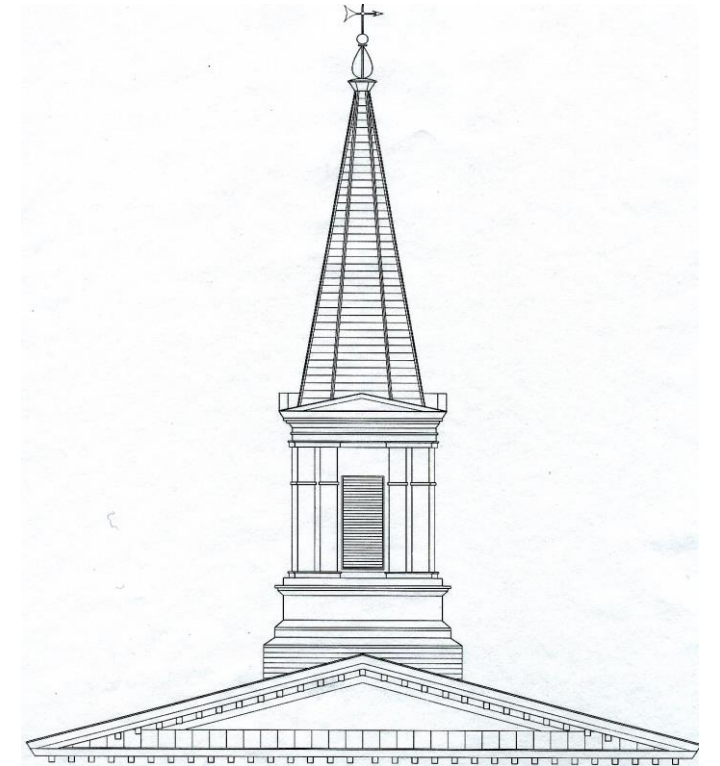

Hymn Time:

"Immortal, Invisible, God Only Wise"
Walter Smith (1824-1908)

The author of this fine worshipful text was Walter Smith. On Christmas Day in 1850, Walter was ordained pastor of the Chadwell Street Scottish Church in London. He later became an important leader of the Free Churches of Scotland. Walter had various volumes of his poetry published throughout his lifetime. To Walter, poetry was "the retreat of his nature from the burden of his labours". He said that poetry allowed him to say what he could not fully express in the pulpit.

In our enjoyment of a personal relationship with God, we sometimes lose sight of the awe and reverence that should also be part of our worship of Him. Often we tend to forget the supreme holiness and greatness of who God really is. In our hymnody and theology we can carelessly treat our Lord as merely "the friend upstairs". Our concept of God is generally too limited. Reflect on this as you sing the words of today's hymn.
