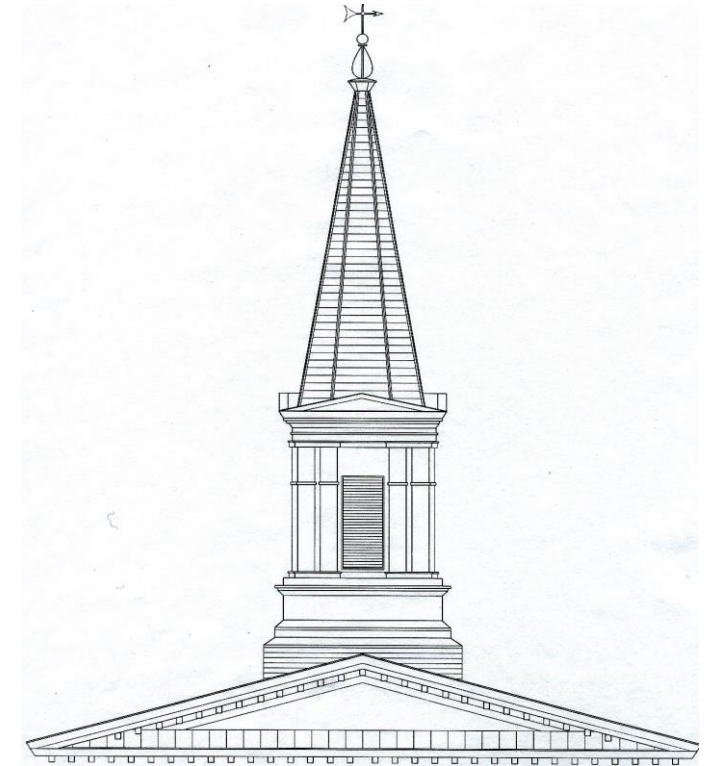

Hymn Time:

"I Love to Tell the Story"
A. Katherine Hankey (1834-1911)

Katherine Hankey was thirty-two years old when she wrote the hymn "I Love to Tell the Story." It arose out of a deep desire in her heart to tell the simple gospel story wherever she was in life. First, it was in the Sunday School of Clapham, England, where she became a devoted, refined consecrated woman. Then, it was in the heart of Africa, where she spent the most of her life, giving the sales of her writings to missions. Finally, it was in the hospitals of London, where she spent the last minutes of her life telling lonely patients of God's beautiful love. When Katherine Hankey wrote "I Love to Tell the Story" in 1866, she was doing more than expressing a feeling in her own being, she was projecting that same feeling into the minds of thousands of people through the years who would sing her song and receive the same challenge.

"I love to tell the story Of unseen things above,
Of Jesus and His glory, Of Jesus and His love,
I love to tell the story, Because I know 'tis true
It satisfies my longings, As nothing else can do."
