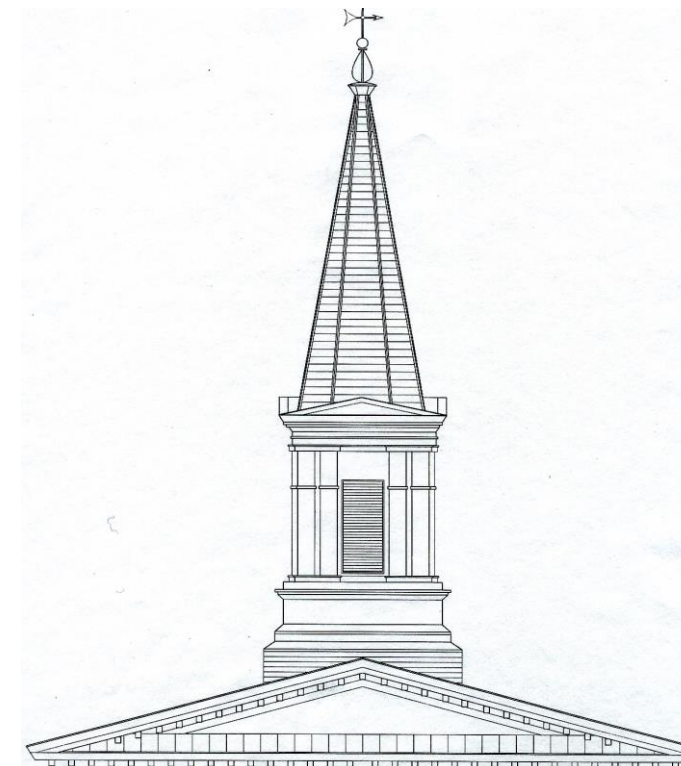

Hymn Time:

"Great is Thy Faithfulness"
Thomas O. Chisholm (1866-1960)

Thomas Obadiah Chisholm was born in a crude log cabin in Franklin, Kentucky. From this humble beginning and without the benefit of high school or advanced education, he somehow began his career as a school teacher at the age of 16 in the same country school where he had received his elementary training. After accepting Christ as his Savior, Thomas became the editor of The Pentecostal Herald and later was ordained as a Methodist minister. Throughout his long lifetime, Thomas wrote more than 1200 sacred poems, many of which have since become prominent hymns.

While many enduring hymns are born out of a particular dramatic experience, this hymn was simply the result of Thomas' "morning by morning" realization of God's personal faithfulness in his daily life. Shortly before his death in 1960, Thomas wrote:

My income has never been large at any time due to impaired health in the earlier years which has followed me on until now. But I must not fail to record here the unfailing faithfulness of a covenant keeping God and that He has given me many wonderful displays of His providing care which have filled me with astonishing gratefulness.
