# Hymn Time:

Hallelujah, What a Savior! Philip Paul Bliss (1838-1876)

Philip P. Bliss wrote words and music to this hymn in 1876 just a short time before his death. He had visited the State prison at Jackson, Michigan, where he heard a stirring address on the subject of "Jesus, the Man of Sorrows."

Bliss was deeply moved and chose "Hallelujah, What a Savior" as his solo for the day. It is said that the presentation was so dramatic that scores of the prisoners were converted on the spot.

This is the last known time that Bliss ever sang a song.


