Hymn Time:

"Thou Didst Leave Thy Throne" Emily Elliott (1836-1897)

This spiritually enriching text differs from the usual Christmas songs since it focuses not only on Jesus' birth, but also on His life on earth, His suffering and death, and the ultimate triumph of His second advent.

This hymn was written by Emily Elliott to teach children the truths of the advent and nativity season. Emily's life was filled with benevolent activities in rescue missions and in the work of the Sunday School movement of that time. She also served as the editor of the magazine "The Church Missionary Juvenile Instructor" and published over 140 hymns. Although Emily wrote this text for the children of her father's church, St. Mark's Anglican Church in Brighton, England, the easily understood wording, the poetic imagery, and the spiritual truths found in these excellent lines soon made the hymn a widespread favorite everywhere to people of all ages.


