"In Christ There Is No East or West" (John Oxenham (1852-1941)

In the year 1908, Winston Churchill made the opening speech at a great missionary exhibition in London called "The Orient in London." Part of the exhibition was a pageant depicting the triumphs of the missionary cause. In charge of the pageant was a minister named Reverend Dugald Macfadyen, nephew of John Oxenham. Macfadyen persuaded his famous uncle to provide the music for the pageant; and part of the music was "In Christ There is No East or West."

This hymn which was so widely acclaimed in that day has never lost its significance; its plea for the fellowship of love has even more profound meaning in our world of today.

"In Christ there is no East or West, In Him no South or North; But one great Fellowship of Love Throughout the whole wide earth."


