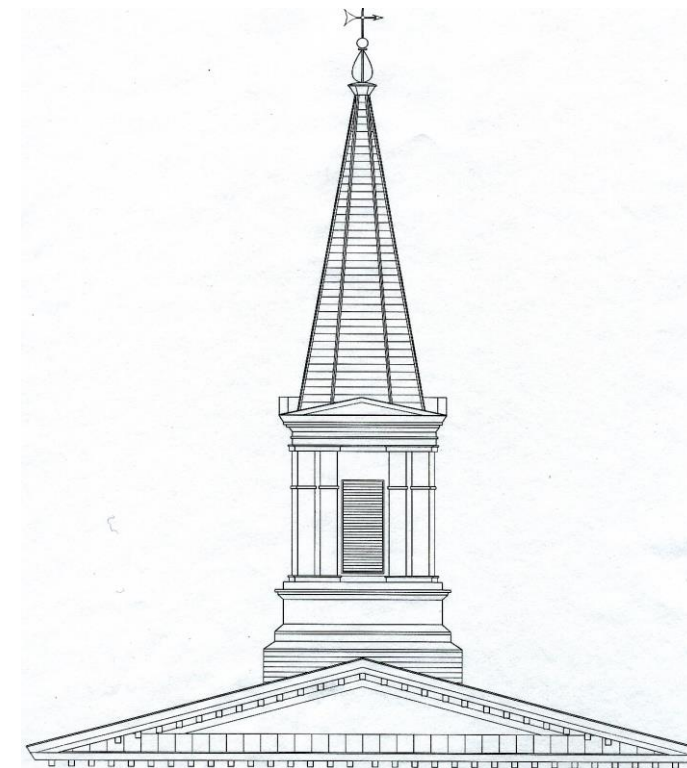

Hymn Time:

"Amazing Grace"
John Newton (1725-1807)

John left school at the age of 11 to begin life as a rough, debauched seaman. Eventually he engaged in the despicable practice of capturing natives from West Africa to be sold as slaves to markets around the world. But one day the grace of God put fear into the heart of this wicked slave trader through a fierce storm. Greatly alarmed and fearful of a shipwreck, John began to read "The Imitation of Christ" by Thomas Kempis. God used this book to lead John to a genuine conversion and a dramatic change in his way of life.

John felt a definite call to study for the ministry and became an ordained minister in the Anglican church at age 39. To add further impact to his powerful preaching, John added simple heart-felt hymns rather than the usual psalms in his services. When enough hymns could not be found John wrote his own, including "Amazing Grace". Until the time of his death at age 82, John never ceased to marvel at the grace of God that transformed him so completely. Shortly before his death, John is quoted as proclaiming during a sermon, "My memory is nearly gone, but I remember two things: That I am a great sinner and that Christ is a great Savior!"
